**Undercover Alcohol Operation
Two Arrests for Sale of Alcohol to Underage Person**

May 10, 2010—Detectives with the Martin County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Unit in partnership with the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco conducted an undercover operation on Saturday, May 8, 2010, at 30 convenience stores in Martin County targeting the sale of alcohol to minors.

Two sales were made to the concerned citizen volunteer that worked with Detectives. Store clerk Maria Najera was arrested at Three Amigos in Indiantown for sale of alcohol to person under 21 and a 16-year-old male clerk was issued a notice to appear at the Daily Stop Food Store in Palm City for sale of alcohol to person under 21. These operations continue year-round. Five previous operations conducted in 2010 resulted in 100% compliance. A previous operation conducted on April 1, 2010 resulted in one arrest.
