### **ASSISTANCE FROM PUBLIC NEEDED BOAT IDENTIFICATION/BURGLARY SUSPECTS**

May 25, 2010—Detectives with the Martin County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division are seeking the assistance of the public in identifying a vessel believed to have been used in burglaries committed at the Piper's Landing Marina in Palm City. Surveillance video shows the vessel, believed to be a 23' Century center console with a black t-top, entering and leaving the area at the time of the burglaries. The vessel appears to have the partial name "Rage". Two white males approximately 25-30 years old are present on the vessel.

Three victims reported to the Sheriff's Office on April 27, 2010, that their boats docked at the marina had been burglarized. Property taken during the burglaries includes fishing rods and reels and a Suzuki brand boat motor.
