Detectives Investigating Report of Home Invasion Robbery

September 21, 2010—Detectives with the Martin County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division are investigating the report of a home invasion robbery that occurred at approximately 11:58 p.m. on September 20, 2010. The victim stated that he was returning to his apartment after visiting a convenience store when he was confronted by two Hispanic males dressed in all black. He stated they were armed with a shotgun and a revolver and forced him into his apartment where his girlfriend was sleeping. The suspects demanded money, jewelry and cellular telephones. The suspects fled the apartment and the victim gave chase, armed with a handgun. The victim stated he fired two shots towards the suspects and that the suspects returned fire in his direction (two shots, both striking a parked vehicle). The suspects then fled the area in a silver Mustang. A search of the area was conducted with negative results. The victim was transported to Martin Memorial Hospital by witnesses and treated for minor injuries (no gunshot wound). There is no video surveillance.

Suspect description:

Two Hispanic males, dressed in all black, both with black thin material beanie-type stocking worn on head, both with black sunglasses. 5'5" and 5'7", red bandanna.

Incident location: 6545 SE Federal Highway, Apt. 201, Stuart, Florida
