**UPDATE/CORRECTION  
Detectives Conducting Investigation – Shooting  
ARRESTS MADE**

April 21, 2011—Detectives with the Martin County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division are continuing their investigation into the report of a shooting in the Banner Lake area of Hobe Sound. The victim has been identified as David Harris, B/M, 02/26/92 – 19 years of age (previous release incorrectly indicated victim is 22 years old.)

Two arrests have been made. Elliott C. Ingvalson, (W/M, 08/04/88) and Glen Francis Theobald (W/M, 09/06/93). Ingvalson and Theobald have stated to detectives that they traveled to the Banner Lake area to meet with Harris and conduct a sale of marijuana. Four ounces of cannabis (packaged in four, one-ounce bags, were located in the vehicle occupied by Ingvalson and Theobald). They stated that Harris tried to rob them of the marijuana, shot at them first, and in fear for their lives Ingvalson shot Harris in the back before fleeing the area. They also stated that there was another black male present during the altercation. Detectives have been unable to locate any evidence that would support their claim of multiple shots being fired or the presence of any other individuals.

Ingvalson remains in custody at the Martin County Jail with bond set in the amount of \$35,000. Theobald was processed at the Martin County Jail and then transferred to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.

## **PREVIOUS RELEASE –**

April 20, 2011—Detectives with the Martin County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division are conducting an investigation into the report of a shooting in the Banner Lake area of Hobe Sound.

Deputies responded to the area adjacent to the park on Lantana Avenue at approximately 5:55 p.m. Martin County Fire Rescue transported the victim, a 22 year old black male, to St. Mary's with life threatening injuries (reported single gunshot wound to the back).

Witnesses reported an altercation occurred between the victim and two white males and stated that after the shooting the two males fled in an unknown direction of travel. A vehicle description was provided and based upon that information Deputies located the vehicle moments later traveling Northbound on Interstate 95. The vehicle was occupied by two white males who were taken into custody without incident and are currently being interviewed by Detectives. At this time, Detectives believe this shooting to be narcotics-related. Charges are pending.

Detectives are working to obtain a search warrant regarding the contents of the vehicle, a 1995 green Ford Ranger. The vehicle has been transported to the Sheriff's Office. At this time no weapon has been recovered.

Victim information is not being released at this time. I do not anticipate the release of any additional information this evening.
