ARREST MADE – NARCOTICS AND CASH SEIZED

January 12, 2011—Martin County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Detective Kevin Kryzda has arrested Jason Arthur Archibald for trafficking in oxycodone, possession of cannabis over 20 grams, and possession of cannabis with intent to sell.

After receiving citizen complaints about a single-family residence located in the Coral Gardens subdivision of Stuart, Detectives began an investigation that resulted in a search warrant being served on January 11, 2011, at 2004 SE Washington Street.

Recovered during the search of the premises: 859 oxycodone pills, 121.2 grams of cannabis, and \$14,250 in cash. Archibald is the only resident of the home and stated to detectives that he routinely purchases large quantities of pills from individuals in Palm Beach County and resells them here in Martin County. He stated he makes between \$1000 - \$1500 per day, charging \$12.00 to \$14.00 per pill.

Archibald is no stranger to law enforcement. He is a convicted felon with previous arrests that include felony battery, possession of controlled substance (cocaine), grand theft, DUI, tampering with evidence, resisting arrest with violence, driving on suspended license, fleeing/attempt to elude, criminal mischief, and multiple violation of probation arrests. He remains in the Martin County Jail with a bond in the amount of \$110,000.
