January 31, 2011—At approximately 12:19 a.m. D/S Kevin Fritchie initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of Federal Highway and Palm City Road in Stuart. The deputy suspected the driver was possibly impaired or in need of medical assistance based on his driving pattern as observed.

When D/S Fritchie approached the vehicle, he ordered the driver to remove his hand from his jacket pocket to ensure officer safety. The driver refused to comply, began to yell at D/S Fritchie, and fled the scene almost striking a marked Sheriff's Office vehicle. The vehicle traveled approximately 3.1 miles South on Federal Highway at a high rate of speed (in excess of 110 mph) before crashing into a ditch at 3555 SE Federal Highway. No other vehicles were involved in the crash.

Located inside the vehicle was a loaded .380 caliber Kel-Tec handgun, narcotics (oxycodone and xanax), and loose ammunition. The driver of the vehicle, Michael Odis Lloyd, was treated and released from Martin Memorial Medical Center before being booked at the Martin County Jail.
